Signs like this can point to issues that cause an apprentice to not complete their program successfully:

- Calling in sick more than usual
- Difficulty concentrating/staying engaged
- Overly confrontational
- Depressed or angry
- Irritability or outbursts
- Overly sharing personal issues/struggles
- Discloses issues with transportation, mental health, domestic violence, housing, childcare, etc.
